The Learning Centre Car Park

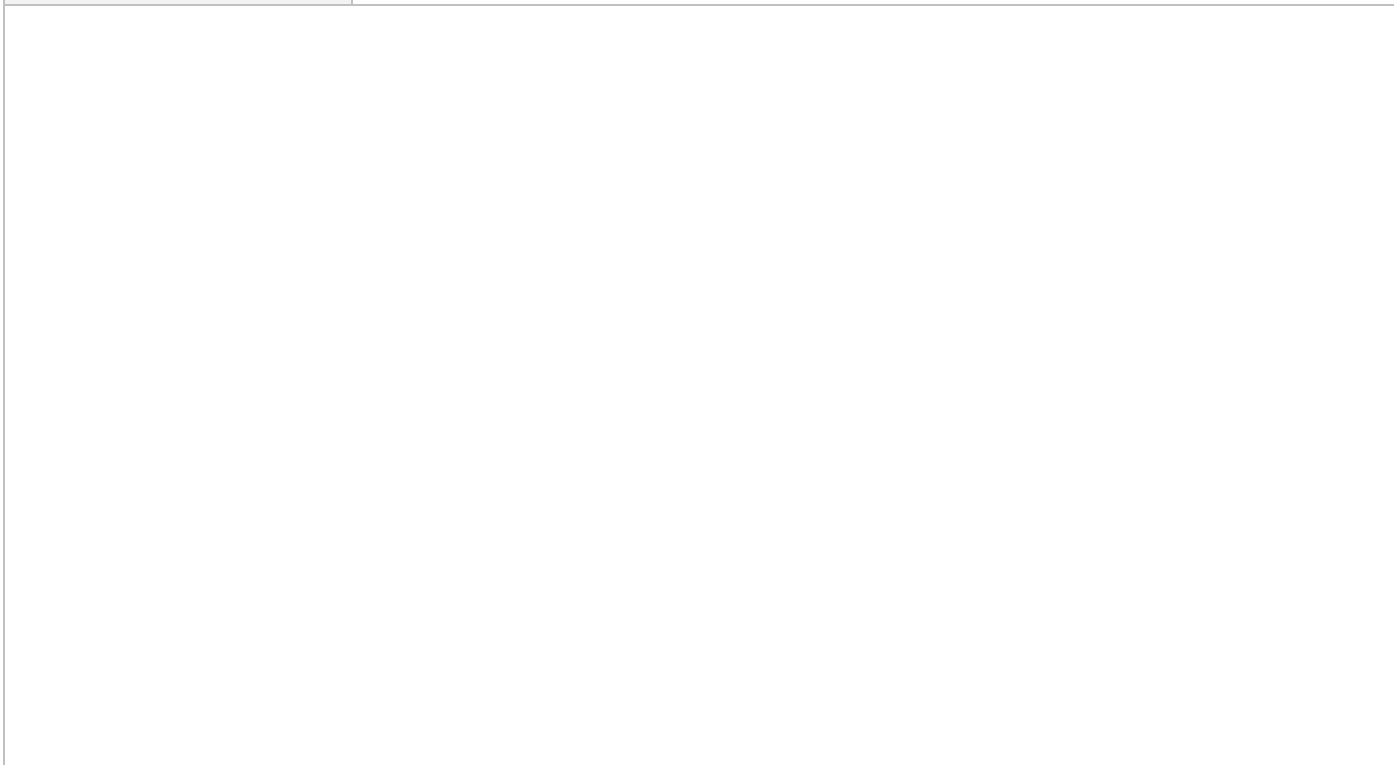
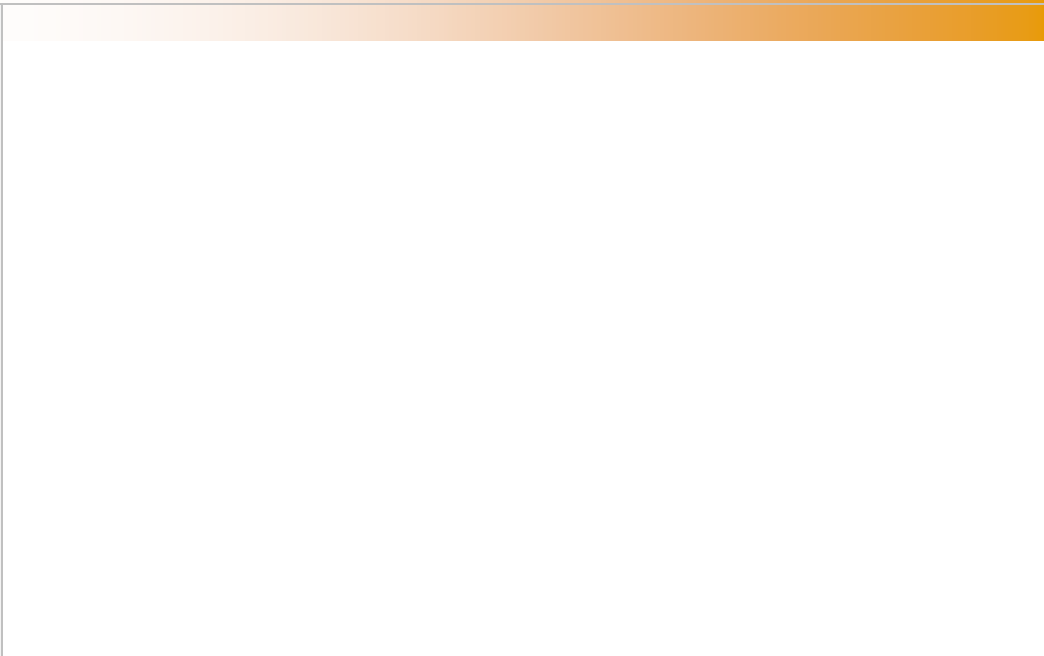
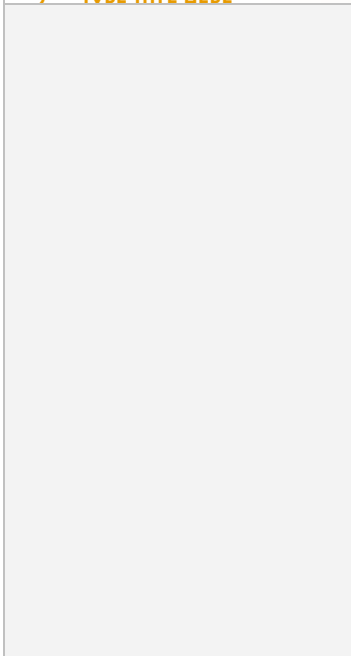
